Principal's Message

Kia ora koutou,

Thank you to everyone who came along to our Meet the Teacher event last Friday. It was lovely to have the school community come together to celebrate the start of the school year, and to meet our wonderful teachers. Once again, a huge thanks to Josh Hawke for all of his work at the pizza oven.

Also on Friday, was our first meeting of the PTA for the year. We have established a draft constitution document, outlining the purpose of the PTA, and are scheduling another meeting for the 21st of March to sign it off, and elect people to different roles within the PTA. Firstly, the new documents are very prescriptive in terms of what teachers need to teach for each year level. The other noteworthy change is that the new Mathematics curriculum in particular is significantly more difficult in terms of what is expected of students as they progress through school.

As a school, we are working really hard to make sure that despite all of these changes, we maintain focus on our students, and their learning. We place high importance on building positive relationships with our learners, and getting to know who they are as individuals, so that we can be well placed to support them to achieve their goals.
